medium-bodied, ripe mellow, mouthfeel

vibrant red berries on the nose with a peppery spice

cab /merlot, oak, berry fruits & spice

syrah, grenache & more, complex aromas and palate

plummy fruit and white spice counterbalanced with a rich, smoky savouriness

EXCLUSIVE SELECTION - WHITE

Chamonix Reserve Sauvignon Blanc Semillon

FRANSCHHOEK R490

pale straw colour, fresh aromas with scents of exotic spice, figs, grapefruit and thyme. On the palate it is full and round with rich fruit sensation and minerality balanced by bracing acidity

Thorne & Daughters Rocking Horse

STELLENBOSCH R560

The nose shows white and yellow fruit, dried herbs, spice and a little earthiness. The palate has a little extra padding, and this is a Rousanne, chardonnay, Semillon, clairette blanche and chenin blanc blend

Alheit La Colline Semillon

FRANSCHHOEK R1395

Sought-after grapes for vines over 80 years old, dried citrus skin, ripe orange, spices, complex concentrated palate with depth and fine acidity

Sadie Family Palladius

SWARTLAND R1595

Brooding stone fruit, spice and a sense of quiet concentration is promised on the nose. The palate is focused, super-complex and is long and lingers chenin blanc integrates well with the other eleven varieties

EXCLUSIVE SELECTION - RED

Kanonkop Cabernet Sauvignon

STELLENBOSCH R870

Incredibly finely proportioned and crisply chiselled, the palate slowly shows extra dimensions of saline cassis, baking chocolate, espresso roast, sweet cedar spice and just the most subtle hints of red plum skins and thyme spice on the finish

Meerlust Rubicon

STELLENBOSCH R995

The nose is brooding, dark bramble fruit, cassis, plum, incense and liquorice, it is still very tightly coiled, slowly offering cigar box, crushed stone and subtle oak spice. Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Cabernet Franc blend

Nederburg Two Centuries Cabernet Sauvignon

PAARL R995

A generous concentration of rich, ripe and sweet dark berried fruits dominates the palate and harmonise with oak to produce a generous, mouth filling profusion of flavours, tempered by firm tannins. Platter 2018 red wine of the year

Shannon Mount Bullet Merlot

ELGIN R995

a fragrance of ripe red fruits such as plums and dark cherries, with earthy complexity and yet still expressing minerality. Maintaining a good acidity lends to outstanding freshness with a well-integrated ripe and seductive tannin structure

Kanonkop Paul Sauer

STELLENBOSCH R1900

Deep, ruby-red colour – concentration of cassis, black currant and tea leaf aromas. Good body with combination of power and elegance.
